



NDC Sanitation and Social Distance Policy

1. All students will be dropped off and picked up from the parking lot in a drive through fashion. (Lobbies are closed). One staff member will be outside accepting students. And another staff member will be inside waiting to receive students and will sanitize all hands as they arrive. All teachers and staff are required to wear masks. Masks are optional for students but encouraged.
2. Each student will remove street shoes and place them on an X that is spaced throughout the walkway at the main entrance of the building. (be sure to wear socks to classes and rehearsals).
3. Dance bags will be placed in an individual cubby or chair assigned to each dancer in the dressing room.
4. The classrooms are taped in 6 ft areas leaving space between each dancer as class sizes are limited to 12, but most classes have 12 or less. There is a taped off area in the classroom for water. The office area is also closed and access to the studio refrigerator and microwave have been restricted. No food items are permitted in the studio (except summer campers).
5. Teachers will use hand sanitizer before and after assisting individual students with movement during classes.
6. Dancers and staff must wash their hands before attending class. Only dancers and staff are allowed to use the restrooms. Dancers will reapply hand sanitizer after restroom use.
7. Between each class all used equipment and surfaces will be wiped with disinfectant including floors, sinks, toilets, chairs, door handles, door knobs, and common areas.
8. New students arriving are met by staff members at the entrance and will have their temperature taken. Departing dancers will now exit from the side door on the left side of the building. (If you're facing the building the exit is on the right.)

9. No electronic devices are allowed (except summer campers). If a student needs to bring a cell phone to the studio it must be placed in a ziplock bag and kept in the dancer's bag.
10. Dancers showing any cold or flu like symptoms in the last 48 hours should remain home. If staff members notice a student that seems ill, parents will be notified and dancers temperature will be checked via laser thermometer by Ms. Grace.
11. Each night, the entire studio will be wiped down completely and cleaned thoroughly.
